  - f. Advancement in Rank: If you enlist in the military after High School, your time in JROTC earns you advanced rank
    - 1) 2 years of JROTC = elevation by one rank (E1 to E2, \$169 more per month)
    - 2) 3 years of JROTC = elevation by two ranks (E1 to E3, \$250 more per month)
